- Designed to be a rapid-response grant opportunity designed to support community-based actions and activities that make neighborhoods safer
- Engage grassroots organizations taking powerful, on-the-ground action in their neighborhoods
- Build community cohesion
- Promote safety & peace



Framework – Seven Field Principles

- 1. Rebuilding the Village / Recreating a sense of community
- 2. Providing access to resources for increasing knowledge
- 3. Providing a sense of connectedness
- 4. Providing opportunity to learn social & emotional skills
- 5. Providing opportunities to increase self-esteem
- 6. Creating intergenerational opportunities and to provide an adult protective shield
- 7. Minimize trauma
